

Booger County Extreme 2007

Race Rules*

1. All team members must complete waivers and equipment checks between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Friday, May 4, 2007 at LaBarge Inc. in Huntsville, Arkansas. All teams and support persons must be present at 8:00 p.m. for a pre-race meeting.
2. Rules may modified at any time before the event. Teams should routinely check this posting for updates. Protests should be reported to race officials in order to be handled by the Race Board.
3. Each team must consist of three members. To receive USARA rankings, a team must be co-ed. All-female teams are eligible for BCE rankings and prizes, but will not be eligible for USARA points or rankings. All-male teams are welcome to run but are not eligible for prizes or BCE rankings. For insurance purposes, all participants must be at least 18 years of age.
4. All 3 original members of each team must check in together at each checkpoint. All members of each team must remain within 100 yards of each other member during the event. All team members must cross the finish line within 50 feet of all other members of their team. Teams must be prepared to call out their team number, team name, and individual names at all checkpoints or whenever asked by race officials.
5. Teams must travel under their own power during the entire race. Any race team member using motorized transportation of any kind during the race will be disqualified.
6. No GPS or special night vision equipment allowed. Emergency cell phones are acceptable. Watches with altimeters are allowed.
7. The time recorded by race officials will be the official time. All finishing times will be posted. The top 3 teams will receive awards and/or prizes at the awards ceremony.
8. All pets must be on a leash. Racers may not bring pets on the course.
9. No alcohol or illegal drug use during event. Any participant found under the influence of drugs or alcohol during the event will be disqualified and asked to leave immediately.
10. Helmets must be worn during all mountain biking, caving, and rope sections.
11. All teams must have a headlight and tail light on each bike, and must illuminate them at all times while on paved roads.
12. All participants and spectators must be safety conscious and leave no litter. Anyone found littering or being destructive will be disqualified and asked to leave immediately.
13. Booger County Extreme is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment.
14. Booger County Extreme reserves the right to alter or terminate the race at any time for safety or emergency purposes. In the event of severe weather, flooding, or other acts of God, the Booger County Extreme race may be altered, terminated, or rescheduled for a later date. All reasonable efforts will be made to prevent these undesirable measures. Thanks for your understanding and cooperation.
